ACTFL Tests: OPI and WPT
Foreign Language Majors ONLY!

- Foreign Language Education majors need to attain a score of Intermediate High or above on the ACTFL Oral Proficiency Interview (OPI) and Writing Proficiency Test (WPT) prior to enrolling in course FOLA 4000/5000. **NOTE: The WPT has replaced the Praxis test for Foreign Language majors. A passing score on the WPT is required prior to student teaching.**
